SUBJECT: Licensing Program Summary

REQUESTED ACTION:

This report is intended to provide the Members with an update on the Licensing Program at the Medical Board of California (Board).

PROGRAM UPDATE:

Due to the change to licensure requirements effective January 1, 2022, the Licensing Program has experienced a significant increase in initial license application volume, which has resulted in an increase in the processing time for an initial license application review for a Postgraduate Training License (PTL), Transition License, and a Physician's and Surgeon's (P&S) License. In Quarter 3 of Fiscal Year (FY) 2021-22, the Board received 3,328 P&S (including Transition applications) license applications, which is a 177% increase from Quarter 2.

The Licensing Program continues to make progress towards a paperless application process, such as eliminating the need for mailed licensed verifications from the issuing state entity, as the Board can verify licensure from other primary sources, such as the Federation of State Medical Boards. This change greatly decreases the volume of mail and eliminates a common application deficiency, which can reduce the overall license application processing time. Licensing Program management and the Board's Information Systems Branch are currently working on steps to only allow applicants to submit the Transition License application online through the BreEZe system. In addition, Licensing staff are currently developing procedures for this new paperless process.

MEXICO PILOT PROGRAM (MPP)

The Board has issued sixteen MPP physician licenses, as requested by the licensees that qualify for licensure. Of the sixteen licensed, two are practicing at their designated clinic and the remainder are going through the credentialing process. Currently seven applicants qualify for licensure but have requested the Board to delay the issuance of their license until they are ready to apply for their visas.

The Board held its second quarterly progress meeting with the UC Davis Center for Reducing Health Disparities on the Mexico Pilot Program evaluation and accompanied the UC Davis team on a scheduled site visit to one of the clinics located in Salinas, CA. The first annual progress report is due in June 2022.

The Licensing Program received 4,596 emails and responded to 4,514 via the Licensing Webmaster in Quarter 3 of the current fiscal year regarding topics such as application status checks, Senate Bill 806 license requirement changes, license renewals, and pocket cards. The number of emails received in Quarter 3 increased 36% from Quarter 2 of the current fiscal year.

CONSUMER INFORMATION UNIT

In Quarter 3 of FY 2021-2022, the Consumer Information Unit (CIU) received 18,397 calls, with an average wait time of 15:32 minutes. Five of the topics most responded to in CIU during this quarter were complaint questions, physician and surgeon application questions, renewal questions, complaint form requested and mailed, and change in license status. Most Licensing Program staff have been provided additional training to assist CIU when call volumes are high to help minimize wait times. The CIU manager is in the process of recruiting for a Supervising Program Technician II to assist with the oversight of CIU staff and management of resources, as staff from the Licensing Program and other Board units continue to assist CIU with calls when wait times are high.

<u>OUTREACH</u>

The Licensing Chief presented on the recent license requirement changes and the application process to the following groups: medical students at the Keck School of Medicine of USC; USC/LAC Office of Graduate Medical Education coordinators; and the UC Graduate Medical Education Coordinator's monthly meeting. The Licensing Chief and the Licensing Outreach Coordinator conducted the 2nd live webinar for license applicants, licensees, and medical school and training program representatives to go over the new licensure requirements effective January 1, 2022, and the application process.
