If you are interested in your school becoming an approved midwifery school with the Medical Board of California, pursuant to California Business and Professions Code Sections 2512.5, 2513, 2514, 2515 and the California Code of Regulations, Title 16, Section 1379.30, please prepare the documents listed below and submit to:

- **Midwifery Education Program Executive Summary:**
A summary of the primary elements for your school and midwifery education program. Must discuss points, such as establishment, key executives, board of directors, achievements, accreditation period, distance learning capabilities, education program improvements and Title IV eligibility.
- **Complete Curriculum/Educational Objectives:**
Include curriculum and educational objectives. Combining your course summaries along with these objectives is appropriate.
- **Midwifery Education Program Examination:**
May be presented in the form of a “test content outline.” This outline will be compared to the regulatory criteria to assure that the examination measures the learning outcomes as it applies to your midwifery education program.
- **Copy of the Summarized Results of a School Accreditation Review:**
The Midwifery Education Accreditation Council self-evaluation report, standards #1-#13, or a comparable evaluative document and documentation of accreditation.
- **Current School Catalog:**
Information published for prospective students. Indicate whether your catalog is under review or is in its final form.
