REQUESTED ACTION

This report is intended to provide the Members with an update on the Licensing Program at the Medical Board of California (Board).

PROGRAM UPDATE

In Quarter 1 of Fiscal Year (FY) 2025-2026, the Board:

- Received 2,500 initial license applications:
 - o 902 Physician's and Surgeon's (P&S) License
 - 539 Transition
 - 1,059 Postgraduate Training License (PTL)
- Issued a total of 3,711 licenses:
 - o 1,720 P&S
 - o 1,991 PTLs

The Licensing Program continues to enhance efficiency, streamline processes, and work to improve applicants' experience. Recent updates and initiatives include:

- Form Updates: Multiple applications have been revised for clarity, consistency, and streamlined submission:
 - The Duplicate Fictitious Name Permit and Application to Restore License to Active were reformatted, and unnecessary fields, such as Social Security Number (SSN), address, telephone, email, and certain certification sections, were removed.
 - The Timeline of Activities Form now clearly requires detailed activity descriptions inside and outside California.

Postgraduate Training Forms:

- The Certificate of Completion of Postgraduate Training (PTA/B) Form was updated to reduce unnecessary documentation for maternity/parental leave and to better capture performance improvement or remediation plans related to disciplinary actions.
- Submission of the Postgraduate Training License Enrollment Form and Program Status Update/Change Form is now available through the DOCS portal, improving transmittal security and efficiency for programs.
- The Research Form has been discontinued, and all references removed from the website, including related questions in other forms.

Process Improvements:

- Applicants without an SSN or Individual Taxpayer Identification Number can now upload deficiency items electronically after receiving a BreEZe PIN.
- A new electronic Quality Assurance review process replaces paper reviews, improving speed, accuracy, and transparency.

These updates reflect the Board's ongoing commitment to providing clear, efficient, and reliable services to applicants and stakeholders while modernizing internal operations.

DOCS UPDATE

The Licensing Program continues to work with training programs and medical schools to update DOCS registration forms to allow broader acceptance of digital signature types. As of November 1, 2025, the Licensing Program received 148,960 uploaded documents for 33,891 applicants. In addition, 4,447 documents were submitted for 3,782 licensees.

LICENSING WEBMASTER

The Licensing Program responded to 2,754 emails from the Licensing Webmaster in Quarter 1 of the current fiscal year. The most common topics during this quarter were license updates, initial renewals, and fictitious name permit questions.

<u>OUTREACH</u>

In Quarter 1, the Board conducted 12 outreach activities (11 in-person, one virtual). During these events, the Board addressed licensing inquiries and guided programs, applicants, and licensees through the licensing and renewal processes. Topics discussed included, but were not limited to, a new ECFMG requirement for Canadian medical school graduates, PTL requirements, and first and second time renewal requirements.

CONSUMER INFORMATION UNIT

In Quarter 1 of FY 2025-2026, the Consumer Information Unit (CIU) received 17,676 calls, with an average wait time of two minutes. The top three topics addressed by CIU during this quarter were renewal assistance, complaint questions, and application questions.
