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Los Angeles Physician Surrenders License to Practice Medicine

SACRAMENTO – The Medical Board has adopted the stipulated surrender of David R. Fett’s license to practice medicine in the state of California, effective February 17, 2017. “The Medical Board’s primary mission is public protection and this action reflects the Board’s ongoing commitment to that mission,” said the Board’s executive director Kimberly Kirchmeyer.

In summary, on October 29, 2015, an Accusation was filed against Fett. The Accusation involved sixteen causes for discipline, which included four separate acts of gross negligence, repeated negligent acts, clearly excessive treatment, and failure to maintain adequate records in the care of four patients.
