Rider Appointed To Medical Board

Dr. J. Alfred Rider was recently appointed to the Board of Medical Examiners by Governor Ronald Reagan. Dr. Rider is Director of the gastrointestinal research laboratory of Franklin Hospital Foundation in San Francisco.

He received his medical degree from the University of Chicago School of Medicine in 1944 and was awarded a Ph.D. in pharmacology from that University in 1951. He later taught medicine at the same university.

He has contributed research and medical articles to the U.S. Food & Drug Administration, Journal of the American Medical Association, Encyclopedia Bri-(continued on back page)
